Code	Activity	Definition
1	Weed Control	Refer to sub categories: 1A – English Broom, 1B – Serrated Tussock, 1C – African Lovegrass, 1D – Blackberry, 1E – Chilean Needle Grass, 1F – Woody Weeds, 1G – Willows, 1H – Patersons Curse, 1I – St John's Wort, 1J – Thistles, 1K – Other Grasses, 1L – Other Weeds e.g. Verbascum
2	Weed Mapping	GPS or manual mapping of weed locations and control work
3	Revegetation	Erosion control, reseedling, tree planting, seedlings, tree planting maintenance including watering and weeding, closing tracks and restoration e.g. Bruce Ridge
4	Seed Collection/Propagation	Collecting grass, shrub and tree seeds, propagation and maintenance of seedlings
5	Native Flora Survey	Surveying and mapping native vegetation
6	Pest Animal Monitoring	Monitoring and mapping pest animals e.g. rabbit warrens
7	Native Fauna Survey	Surveying and mapping native fauna e.g. Superb parrot
8	Track Maintenance	Trail maintenance multi use trails e.g. Bruce Ridge
9	Environmental Events	Open days, displays at shopping centres, formal events such as World Environment Day, Tidbinbilla Extravaganza, ministerial launches, Landcare Awards
10	Training	Training e.g. induction, ChemCert, field days, seminars, workshops and conferences
11	Meetings	Volunteer group meetings, ParkCare/Landcare Coordinators, Catchment Group, meetings for specific issues such as Centenary Trail
12	Administration	Reporting, liaison with Districts and ParkCare Coordinator, preparation of publications and signs, photography, newsletters, grant applications, volunteer group management, organising events.
13	Other	ParkCare/Landcare Christmas party
